







The route follows the cycle path from either Station Road or Westerleigh Road onto the Common, where it meanders through the copse. This is home to many species of birds including Robins, Blue Tits, Great Tits, Thrushes, Wrens and Blackbirds and also rabbits and squirrels.



The path leads onto grass by the pond, which is a haven for wildlife. There are seats so stay awhile and look for dragonflies, ducks hiding in the reeds, foxes coming for a drink, birds of prey hovering overhead and herons, waiting patiently for a stickleback or two. There are many integrating pathways that the more adventurous walker can use, making the Common a place for all the family to use and enjoy.
